Rosecrance provides a range of prevention, intervention, and mental health treatment services for individuals and families. Counseling, psychiatric therapy, case management, residential services, and some other services are provided. A Psychiatric Care Program is available for patients who were in the criminal justice system within the past six months. You can call to schedule an appointment or walk-in on Tuesday, Wednesday, and Thursday from 8 am-3:30 pm to start the intake process. Mental health assessments are scheduled on a first come, first served basis, so arrive at 8 am to try to complete an assessment on the same day.

Frances Nelson Mental Health Center provides counseling services (individual therapy). The psychiatrist at Frances Nelson is not currently accepting any new patients. You must call to schedule an appointment with a counselor. It is required provide proof of insurance and proof of income on the day of your first appointment if you are a new Frances Nelson patient. Medicaid is accepted and individuals without insurance can receive sliding scale services.

Financial assistance for low-income individuals

The Pavilion is a for-profit mental health provider that offers screening and assessment services for free. You can either call to schedule an appointment or walk-in at any time. However, all psychological and psychiatric care is provided with a fee. Medicaid is accepted for individuals under 21 years of age.

The first visit at Campion Barrow and Associates must be paid in full (\$250 or \$210 depending on the type of mental health professional you see), however, other financing can be done on an individual basis. They only see people who have an appointment and the wait time to get a first appointment is 1 to 2 weeks.

Counseling is available to all individuals, couples, and families. No one is denied needed services based on their inability to pay. Waiting list for new clients is about 4 months long.

Christian Health Center provides psychological and psychiatric services to patient. A patient must indicate the need for primary care first. Then, the patient can be referred internally to a psychiatrist. The mental health services provided at the Christian Health Center are ideal for low-risk patients. Mental Health Services are offered every second Monday of each month.

The center also provides the Bureau of Prisons Program, with intensive case management services to assist in the inmates' transition back into the community (for more information call Charles Lyons at 217-356-7576). The Prairie Center is the local provider to the Drug Court programs of Champaign County and Vermillion County.
