Rosecrance provides prevention, intervention, and mental health treatment services for individuals and families. Counseling, psychiatric therapy, case management, residential services, and some other services are provided. A Psychiatric Care Program is available for patients who were in the criminal justice system within the past six months. You can call to schedule an appointment or walk-in on Tuesday, Wednesday, and Thursday from 8 am-3:30 pm to start the intake process. Mental health assessments are scheduled on a first come, first served basis, so arrive at 8 am to try to complete an assessment on the same day.
