- Carle Clinic's policies deny, limit, or price out of reach health care appointments and services to over 40% of our County's people.
- Those who can't get health care appointments and services because of Carle Clinic's policies include:
  - people with Medicaid insurance (approx. 20,449)
  - people without insurance (approx. 54,990)
  - people who may be insured but have medical debt and can't meet unreasonable payment demands of Carle Clinic (unknown number of individuals)
- **Join the Health Care Access Task Force in demanding that Carle Clinic change its harmful and discriminatory policies and start providing care to our community!**
