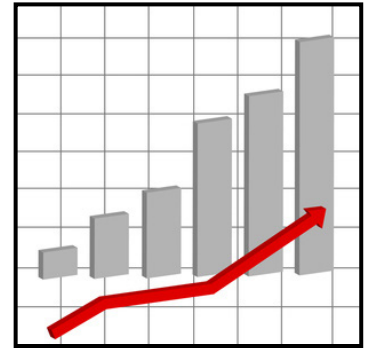


Have your health insurance premiums gone up by more than 10% in the last year?

The Illinois Department of Insurance wants to hear about all double-digit premium increases as it is currently working on legislation that would give the Department regulatory power to approve and deny health insurance premium increases.

Champaign County Health Care Consumers is available to help you file a complaint against your health insurance company if you have had a double-digit increase in your monthly health insurance premiums.

Your complaint can help the Department of Insurance to gain the power to stop insurance companies from continuing to increase your health insurance premiums at unreasonable rates year after year.
