The Christian Health Center provides free primary care to uninsured adults. They also have referral slots to the Frances Nelson Health Center and other health care facilities to ensure patients receive follow-up care, if needed. Some of the services include physicals for both adults and children, and screenings for high blood pressure, diabetes, and cholesterol.
