- Free mammograms
- Free breast exams
- Free pelvic exams
- Free Pap tests
- Free breast and cervical cancer treatment

Services covered:

- Physical exam and health history
- Patient education and counseling about women's health, family planning and how to plan for a healthy pregnancy if and when you want to have a baby
- Birth control
- Pap tests
- Sterilization services, like getting tubes tied, for patients who are 21 years of age or older
- Mammograms, when ordered by the doctor at your family planning visit
- Lab tests necessary for family planning, birth control or related reproductive health
- Testing and medicine for sexually transmitted infections found during the family planning exam, including HIV testing
- Multivitamins and folic acid

You are eligible for Illinois Healthy Women if:

- You are at least 19 and no older than 44
- You are a U.S. citizen or legal permanent resident with a Social Security number
- You live in Illinois
- You meet the income guidelines
- You have no health insurance coverage for birth control
- You are currently not pregnant*
