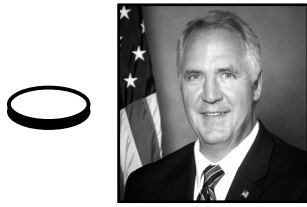

Register to Vote TODAY

To register, you must:

- ✓ Be at least 18 years old on or before November 6.
- ✓ Be a U.S. citizen.
- ✓ Be a resident of that precinct for at least 30 days prior to election day.

If you have been in prison, have been convicted of a felony, are on probation, or you are homeless, you CAN register to vote!

You must register to vote by October 9 to vote in the November 6 general elections.

Going to Vote

What You Need To Know When You Go To Vote:

- You do NOT need to show your Voter Registration card to vote.
- You MAY need to show a picture ID the first time you vote, if you used the "Motor Voter" form to register.

Finding Your Precinct & Polling Place:

- Your Voter Registration card lists your precinct's polling place.
- If you are unsure of where to go, call your County Clerk's Office.

Absentee & Early Voting:

- Absentee voting is open Sept. 27 - Nov. 2. You can vote in person at your County Clerk's Office OR by mail.
- Early voting is open Oct. 22 - Nov. 3. You can vote in person at your County Clerk's Office OR at a designated location.

Voting at the Polls:

- Election Day is Tuesday, November 6, 2012.
- The polls are open from 6 a.m. - 7 p.m.
- Vote at your designated polling place.
